ASH WEDNESDAY: This coming Wednesday is Ash Wednesday. Ashes will be blessed and distributed at both Masses on Wednesday 5 March, the 9.30am Mass in Datchet and the 10.30am Mass in Eton. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are observed as days of fasting and abstinence. Fasting means we reduce the amount of food we eat, and abstinence means we give up meat or some other food or alcoholic drink or some form of amusement. Unless someone has special dietary requirements, those over eighteen are bound by the law of fasting until their sixtieth year, and those over fourteen are bound by the law of abstinence.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: will be prayed every Friday during Lent after the 9.30am Mass. During Lent Benediction will be every Thursday after the 9.30am Mass.

LENTEN SOUP will be served in St. Augustine's Jubilee Hall after the 11am Mass all Sundays in Lent, starting 9 March. Donations will be requested to support CAFOD. More details to follow.

Always required: tea, long life sponge puddings, tinned tomatoes, tinned meat.

Toiletries & Basic Items Urgent: washing up liquid, shampoo, deodorant, shaving foam/gel, toothpaste, child toothbrushes, nappies size 6+, 7 & 8.

Always required: soap, toilet rolls, strong carrier bags.
